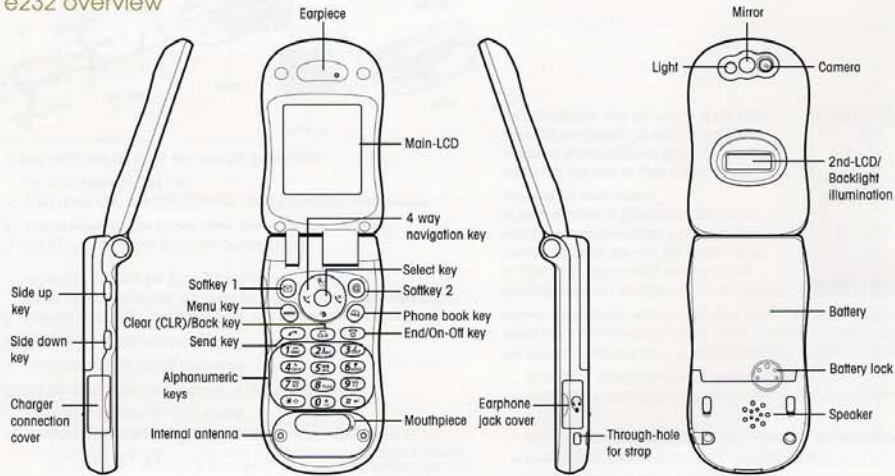

Shortcuts - quick reference

The e232 has quick access to many functions directly from the standby screen using the shortcuts below:
